## Lesson Plan 1: Dáil 100

### Learning Intentions

At the end of this lesson students will

- 1. Understand the political background to the 1918 election,
- 2. Appreciate the significance of the election from the point of view of female suffrage and the decline of the Home Rule party,
- 3. Be able to describe key terms such as Abstention and Conscription.

#### Introduction

Working in pairs get students to write down everything they know about the 1916 Easter Rising. Get them to share their findings with other pairs and you. Watch the <u>Powtoon animation</u> to give students an idea of what is coming up in this lesson and to see did they get any of the words or people during the introductory exercise.

#### Development

Deliver the <u>Background to the 1918 general</u> <u>election</u> slideshow available on the Dáil 100 website.

#### Conclusion

At the end of the lesson get the students to complete a 3-2-1 exercise and ask them to think about the decision to set up a parliament in Dublin and in particular what steps would you take if you were in that position.
